### Year of India 2011 in Canada – participation in Canadian Tulip Festival, Ottawa

As part of ongoing Year of India 2011 in Canada, various events were organised in the Tulip Festival Ottawa from 14 to 23 May 2011. **Chinh India: The Nomadic Orchestra of the World** participated in the festival which received enthusiastic response from the public. In addition, **five** President Award winning **Master Craftsmen** displayed their crafts in the festival. The craftsmen, led by Mr. A M Abdul Kader, Deputy Director, were sent by the Ministry of Textile, Office of the Development Commissioner, Handicrafts, New Delhi. On 14 May, **India Day** was celebrated at the Tulip Festival. Also included were food bazaar and workshops. The Chinh India Nomadic Orchestra also gave performances in Montreal, Brampton/Mississauga, Regina, and Edmonton.

## **Industrial output registers 7.3 per cent growth in March 2011**

India's industrial output, as measured by the Index of Industrial Production (IIP), has risen sharply 7.3 per cent in March 2011, as compared to the corresponding period a year earlier. The IIP almost doubled the revised 3.7 per cent expansion registered in February 2011. Exports rose 34 per cent to record US\$ 23.9 billion in April 2011, while imports were up 14.1 per cent to US\$ 32.8 billion. The output of consumer durables reportedly expanded 12.3 per cent while that of non-durables rose 5.5 per cent.

## **Marine exports at record levels despite recession effect**

According to provisional estimates of Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA), the earnings from export of marine products crossed the landmark figure of US \$ 2.5 billion in 2010-11, the highest ever. The export of marine products during April - March 2010-11 touched US \$ 2.67 billion, a growth of 10.96 per cent in quantity, 20.42 per cent in rupee value and 25.55 per cent in US\$ terms, compared to last year.

The achievement came in spite of the after effects of recession in the international market, Rupee becoming stronger vis-à-vis the Euro and the Dollar, and the impact of the collapse of economies in Greece, Spain and Portugal in the EU region causing the depreciation of Euro against US dollar. EU is the largest market for Indian seafood items for the last five years.

Considerable increase was made in the export of frozen shrimp and frozen squid during the period. Large-scale production of Vannamei shrimp in addition to high productivity of black tiger shrimp and increased landing of squid might be attributed for the increase.

## **Bilateral trade up**

India-Canada bilateral trade continued to show an upward trend. During the first quarter of 2011 (Jan-Mar), the total bilateral trade stood at US\$ 1.167 billion as against US\$ 0.889 billion, up 31.7 per cent during the same period in 2010. India's exports to Canada at US\$ 65.56 million registered 38.7 per cent increase whereas India's imports from Canada at US\$ 51.14 million were up by 22.6 per cent over the same period in 2010.



## **New export strategy puts target at \$ 500 billion**

Commerce and Industry Minister Anand Sharma unveiled a new strategy to double the exports to \$500 billion during the next three years.

“We must aim for more than a doubling of exports in the three years to \$500 billion. This is achievable with a determined effort. We cannot afford any less than this,” stated the strategy paper released by the Minister. For achieving the \$500 billion mark, the country's exports should grow annually by 26.7 per cent. The strategy hinges on aggressive marketing of “Brand India” and reducing export transaction costs to make exports more competitive and viable. The export drive would be led by sectors like engineering, gems and jewellery, chemicals, pharmaceutical and textiles.

In a splendid performance, exports surpassed the target of \$200 billion and aggregated \$246 billion in 2010-11 despite slow demand and financial problems in some European markets. The surge in exports came mainly from the U.S., some Western European markets and new destinations like Latin America and Africa.

There is need to focus on new markets like Asia, South America, Pacific and Far East. “We are going to give incentives to these regions. We will take it forward having preferential trade agreements, free trade pacts in these regions to ensure that our industry and exporters have a better access in these markets,” Mr. Sharma said.

The Commerce Ministry would also promote high technology exports which would cover biotechnology, electronic hardware, automobiles, computer based smart engineering, environmental goods and high-end areas of aerospace engineering.

## **Buyers credit' launched to boost project exports from India**

On 07 April, Commerce and Industry Minister, Mr Anand Sharma, launched a new product – ‘Buyer's Credit under the National Export Insurance Account (NEIA)’ – to boost project exports from India. The scheme has been developed by Export-Import Bank of India (Exim Bank) along with the Export Credit Guarantee Corporation of India (ECGC). The product is to ensure that Indian companies are in a competitive position in project bids vis-a-vis their peers from other nations. The Buyer's Credit facility can be used by sovereign Governments and Government-owned entities overseas to finance import of projects from India on deferred payment terms. Project exports include civil construction (of structures and infrastructure), turnkey projects, process and engineering consultancy services.

The loan would be disbursed for large project exports especially in the infrastructure sector, such as roads, bridges, railways, power line, sewerage plants, water treatment facilities and housing. A single project exposure covered by the loan could be \$100 million (or `450 crore). A higher amount, of even up to \$2 billion, could be considered if the project is strategically important to India, sources said.



NEIA, a Trust with a corpus of `2,000 crore, was set up by the Ministry to provide export credit insurance cover for promoting project exports from India administered by ECGC. ECGC aims to strengthen the export promotion drive by covering the risk of exporting on credit. Developing countries are the major markets for India's project exports, and these countries demand medium-to long-term credits.

### **India to add 67,000 MW solar power capacity by 2022**

According to a report by KPMG, technological breakthroughs and economies of scale will make solar power competitive in six years and help India add 67,000 megawatts of solar generation capacity by 2022 - more than thrice the country's target. Solar energy can contribute 7% of the total power needs of the country by 2022, helping cut coal imports by 30% or 71 million tonnes a year resulting \$5.5 billion saving in imports per year from 2022 onwards, said the report. "The present trends indicate that the prospects are very bright for solar power to be equal to conventional electricity any time after 2017, said a senior official from the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy.

### **Hilton Group plans to add 10 new hotels in India**

According to a news item, the international hotel chain - the Hilton Group - plans to add 10 new hotels in India over the next two years to tap the growing domestic market, "Our ambition is to become the largest (international) chain in India over the next five years," Hilton Worldwide President and CEO Christopher J. Nassetta told reporters at the unveiling of their first hotel in Chennai. Chennai Hilton is a 10-storey building offering accommodation ranging from deluxe rooms to executive rooms and suites. Nassetta said the Group would increase the number of Hilton Group hotels in India from the present 4 hotels to 14 within two years.

### **ISRO to launch French satellite in 2012**

Continuing its programme of commercial launch of foreign satellites, Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has lined up launch of an image capturing satellite of France next year, according to Parivakkam Subramaniam Veeraraghavan, Director, Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC), a unit of ISRO. The French satellite SPOT (Satellite Pour l'observation de la Terre) is a high-resolution, optical imaging, earth observation satellite system. Currently SPOT 5 is working in the space and is expected to be withdrawn by the end of 2013. India will launch the SPOT 6 satellite, which will provide continuous high definition images of earth.

On 6 April, Quebec City based H2O Innovation Inc. announced that its Indian joint-venture, H2O Innovation India Ltd., Mumbai, has opened its first manufacturing plant near Vadodara, India. The new production capacity will enable H2O Innovation India to locally ensure detailed engineering, together with assembly, welding, pipe fitting, in-house performance testing and programming, among other operations. H2O Innovation India has also secured C\$4.2 million in bookings of water treatment systems and equipment for Indian industrial customers. H2O Innovation India is a joint venture between Chembond Chemicals Limited of Mumbai and H2O Innovation. It provides water treatment solutions and operation and maintenance services to South Asian countries.

Grand Power Logistics Group Inc., a Calgary-based international logistics provider, announced that it has entered into an exclusive partnership with Necko Freight Forwarders Ltd. of India for the development of India-Hong Kong-Greater China airfreight and ocean freight markets. Grand Power's services include comprehensive airfreight and ocean freight services, rail and land transportation, customs brokerage, warehouse and distribution, and global freight management services.
